Geographical skills and fieldwork:

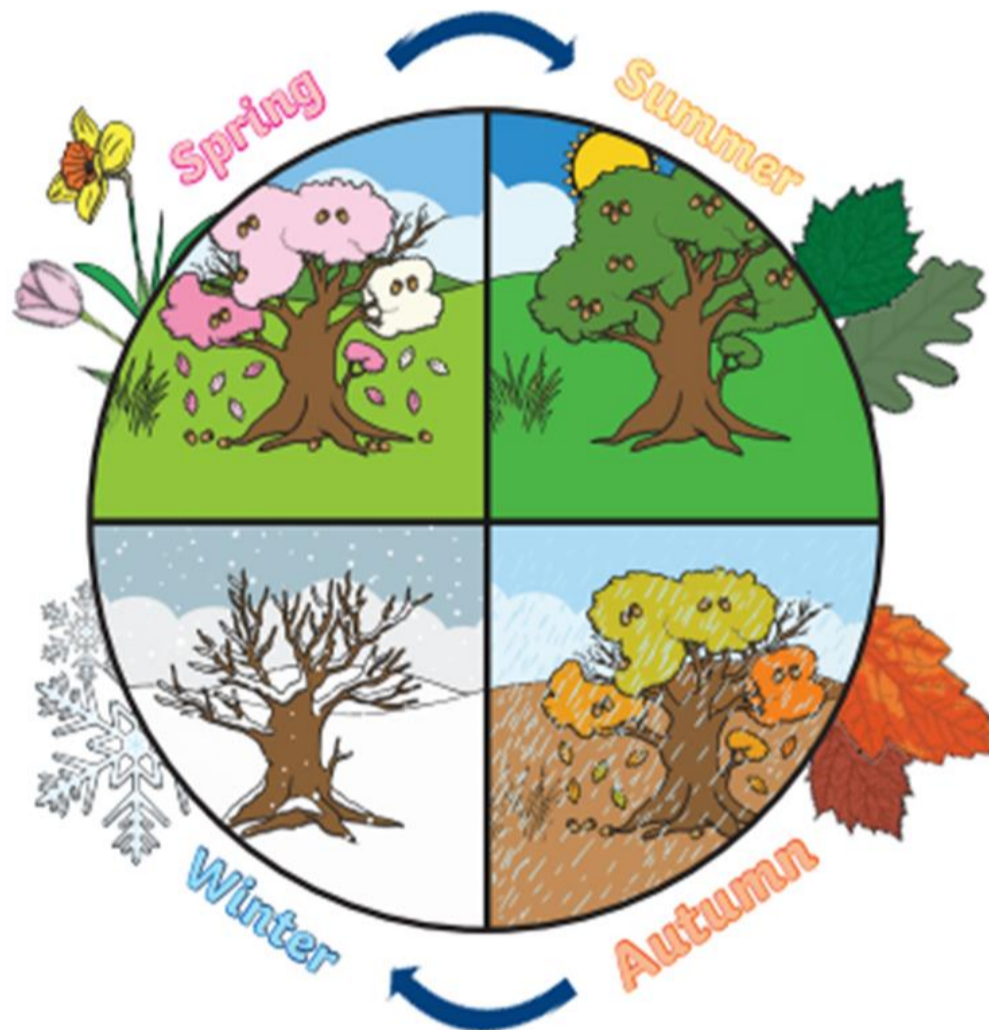
- We will stand still and close our eyes. What can you see, hear, smell, touch, taste? Then, open your eyes – what can you see?

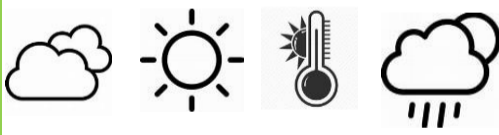
can be sunny, rain, cloudy and windy

- ✓ Ladybirds
- ✓ Frogs
- ✓ Trees full of leaves

can rain, starts mild then can get colder, windy

Look out for:

- ✓ Leaves dropping their leaves
- ✓ Caterpillars in cocoons
- ✓ Slugs and snails under leaves
- ✓ Hedgehogs hibernating
- ✓ Squirrels burying nuts

Winter

can be wet, snowy and frosty

Look out for:

- ✓ Trees with no leaves
- ✓ Evergreen plants
- ✓ Geese and Robins
- ✓ Animals building underground nests to stay warm
