Geographical skills and fieldwork:


- We will stand still and close our eyes. What can you see, hear, smell, touch, taste? Then, open your eyes — what can you see?

National Curriculum: science

- Observe and describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies

- ✓ Evergreen plants
- ✓ Geese and Robins
- \checkmark Animals building underground nests to stay warm

Look out for:

- ✓ Frog spawn
- ✓ Caterpillars
- ✓ Baby animals
- ✓ Birds building nests

Look out for:

- ✓ Flowers
- ✓ Bees
- ✓ Ladybirds
- ✓ Frogs
- ✓ Trees full of leaves


