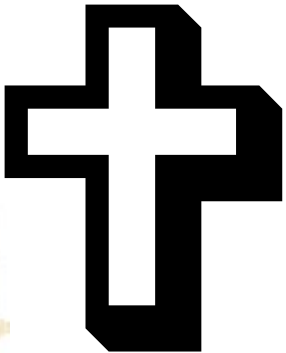
Why is Jesus called the Saviour?

Key knowledge for this unit

Many Christians believe:

- ✚ Jesus died on the cross when he was crucified
- ✚ There was a resurrection and Jesus rose from the dead. Easter Sunday marks Jesus' resurrection.
- ✚ Jesus' death was a sacrifice which saved all of humankind.
- ✚ Before Jesus lived on Earth something had gone wrong with human life and this prevented humans from having 'eternal life'

Jesus is called the **Saviour** by many Christians, this is because they believe:

- ✚ Because Jesus died on the cross, humankind had been saved from what had gone wrong, evil had been defeated and eternal life for those who had faith was now possible

Word	Definition
crucifixion	Jesus's death on a cross
eternal life	Living forever
resurrection	The belief that Jesus rose from the dead
sacrifice	To do something that involves hardship or suffering, usually so that something good or better can be achieved
saviour	Someone who rescues another person or thing from danger or harm

Many Christians also believe:

- ✚ Eternal life never ends, and it is a transformed new kind of life that is better than life on Earth
- ✚ When Jesus died on the cross, he was not bitter or angry with those who put him to death and this is believed to be reflected in the prayer he spoke when he was on the cross, in which he said, "Father, forgive them for they do not know what they do."
