

- ${\bf r}$ Some of the main events in the Easter story are: when Jesus was arrested and when Jesus was put on trial.
- On the day known as Good Friday, Jesus was crucified on a cross.
- On the day known as Easter Sunday, Jesus rose from the dead.
- Christians believe that Jesus' death and resurrection gives them eternal
- Christians believe that when they die they go to heaven to be with Jesus and have a new life that is much better.


