
Year 1 have enjoyed a fabulous visit to teach them all about Magical Museum Old Toys! The children took part in an interactive workshop and learned loads for their history topic!

You can apply online. Online applications need to be submitted by 15 January 2024 by midnight.

This method is preferred by parents as it is quick and easy to do with the following benefits:

- E-mail decision received after 2pm on 16 April 2024
- You can apply 24 hours a day, 7 davs a week
- There's no risk that your application will be lost in the post as you will get email confirmation that your application has been received
- It's safe and secure

If you do not want to apply online, you can complete a paper application form. Forms need to be returned by 15 January 2024 by 5pm.

- You will need to contact the School Admissions Service on 0300 555 2345 for a form to be issued to you
- Parents are strongly encouraged to return the form by recorded delivery as acknowledgements of receipt are not sent by the service
- Please note, if you do choose this method your offer is posted on 16 April 2024 by second class post direct to the home address
