Challenge Curriculum Learning Challenges	<p><u>What would you have done after school during the last 100 years?</u></p> <p>KS2 History: A study of an aspect or theme in British history that extends beyond 1066: leisure and Entertainment in the 20th century.</p>	<p><u>Why is the sound that *'One Direction'* makes enjoyed by so many?</u></p> <p>Science Y4: (Sound and Lower KS2 Working Scientifically) Identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating.
